

Augmenting bilateral agreements with SAP Intelligent Hubbing 365

The service deployed by EE, SAP Intelligent Hubbing 365, is composed of multiple physical servers sharing the same Global Title and two different IP addresses behind a load balancer, which is responsible for serving many of SAP's operator customers. SAP Intelligent Hubbing 365 includes a dedicated platform called the number resolution system (NRS), which addresses mobile number portability (MNP), a standard used in many countries around the world.

SAP also provides EE with access to an SMS report manager. This is a hosted, secure, Web-based SMS reporting platform that enables the company to view its international SMS messaging traffic.
