Mary Beth Hanss is general counsel for SAP in the United States. In this role, she manages the legal and contracts department supporting all SAP business in the United States.

Mary Beth came to SAP in 1997, where she initially served through 2002 as legal counsel for the newly formed SAP subsidiary focused on the U.S. public sector. During this time, Mary Beth was instrumental in establishing and building the new subsidiary, including the legal, contracts, and proposals departments, ultimately leading to her promotion to assistant general counsel in 1999 and vice president in 2000.

Mary Beth moved to the SAP America legal department in 2003, where she managed many aspects of the department. In 2008 she was promoted to senior vice president and general counsel for SAP America.

Before joining SAP, Mary Beth was employed as an attorney with Oracle Corporation, Amdahl Corporation (now a subsidiary of Fujitsu), and the law firm of Kowalczyk, Deery & Soja.
